




School Sporting Tour Headline Results

survey.

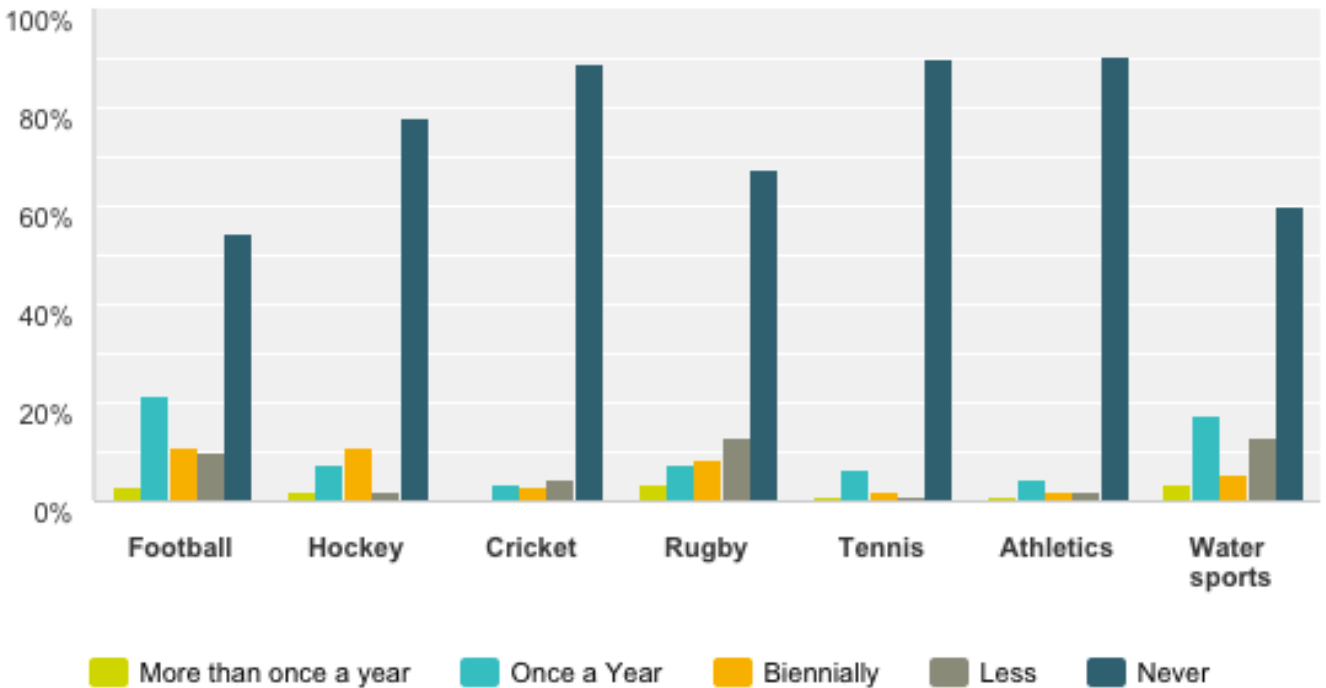


76% of school run residential or touring sport tours.

Compared to 2 years ago the number of sporting trips have..

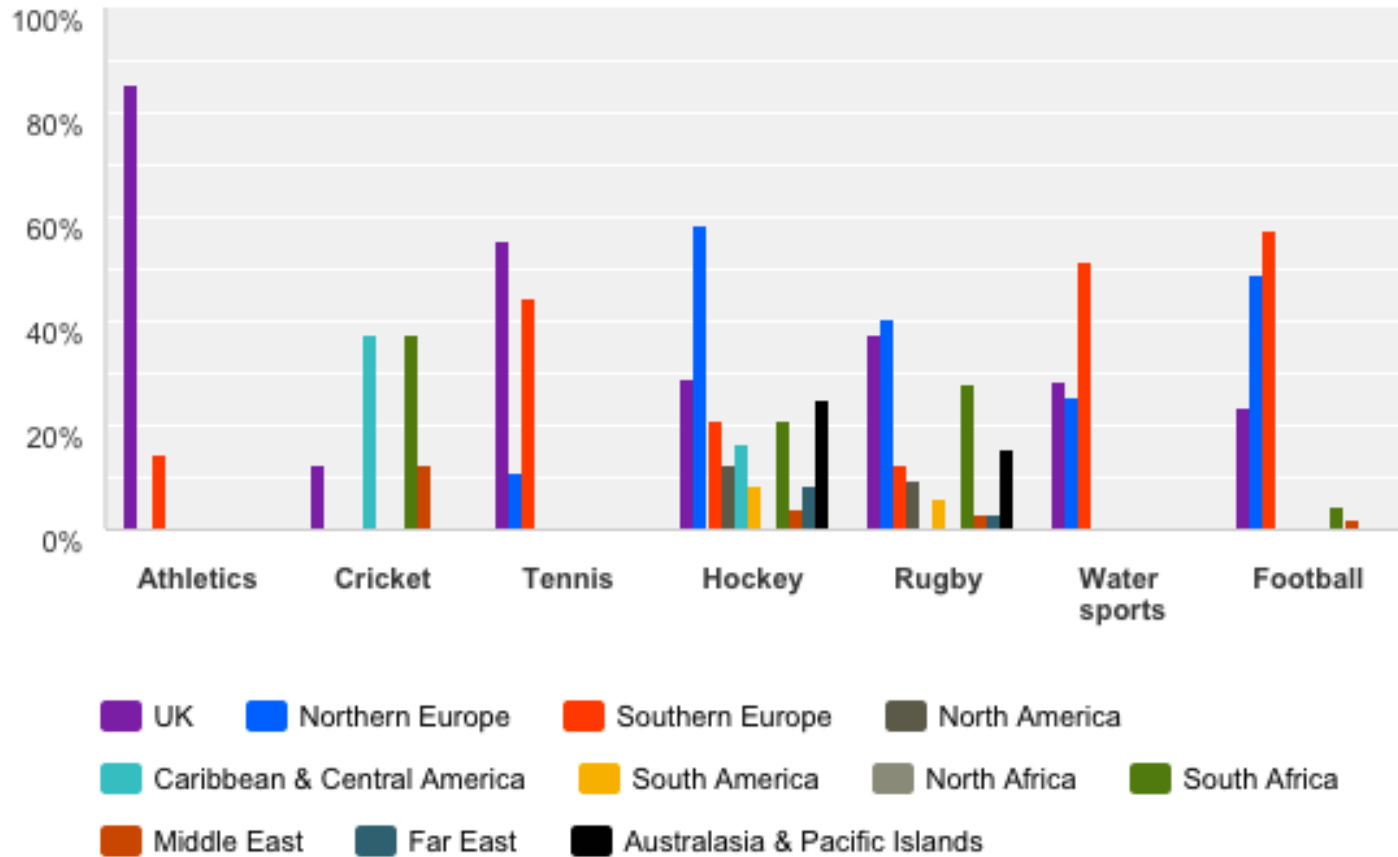
- Increased in 25% of schools

Destination of sporting trips

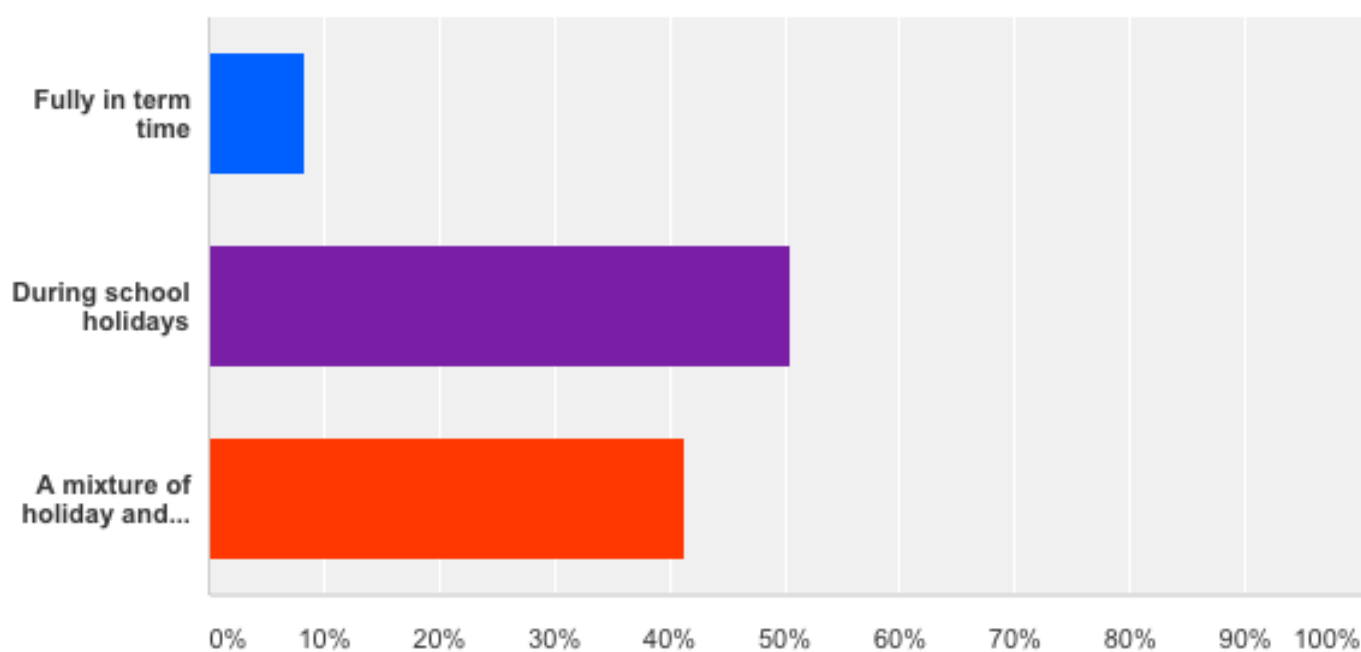


Hockey and Rugby seem to have the largest span of destinations.

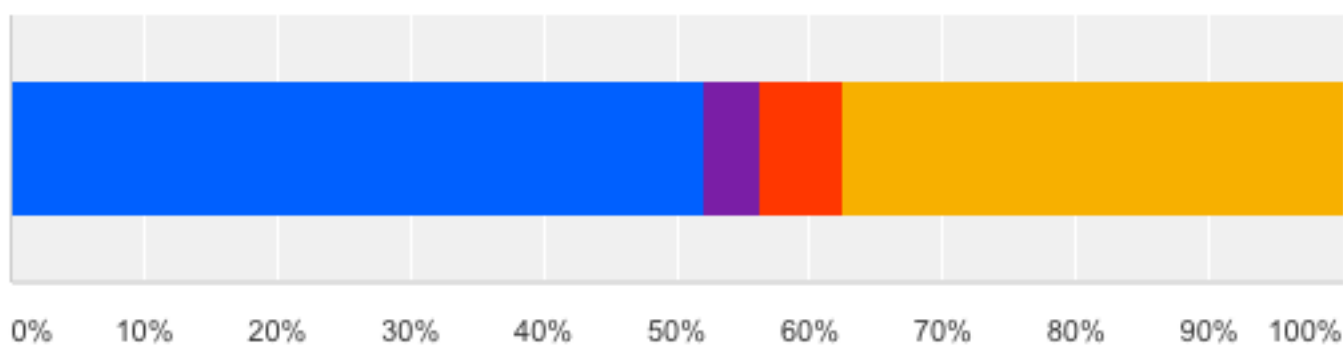

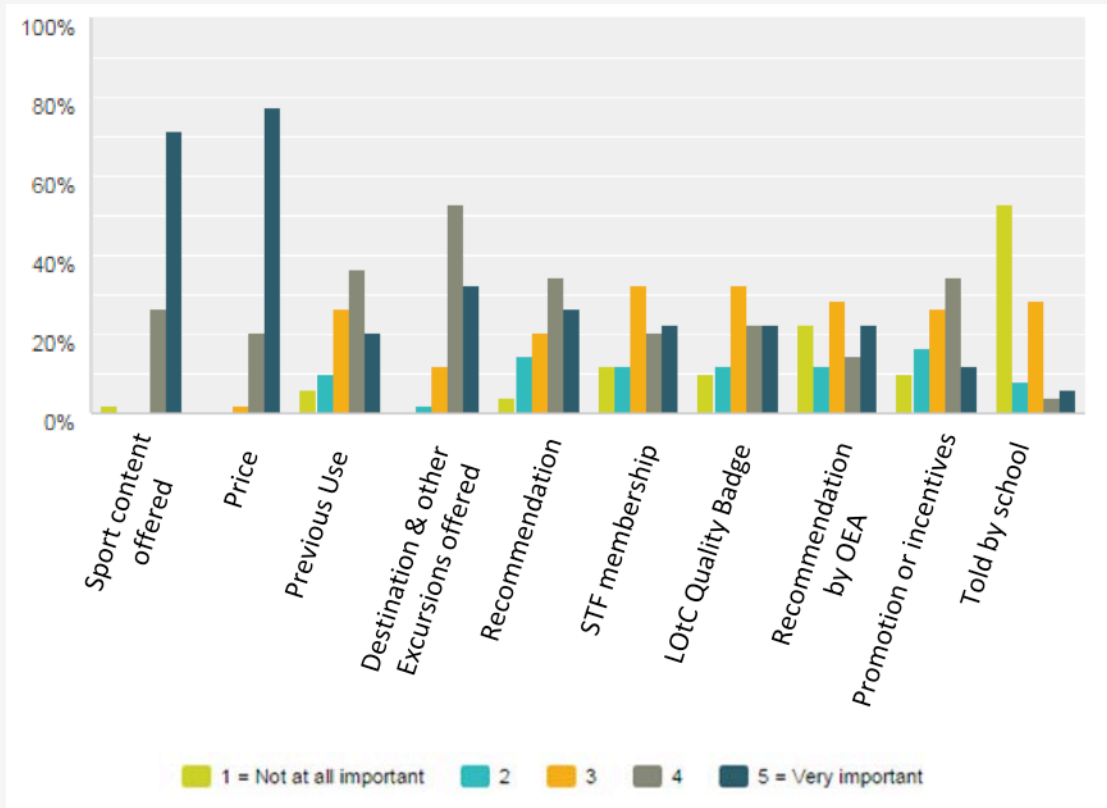


How are schools organising their Sporting tours?

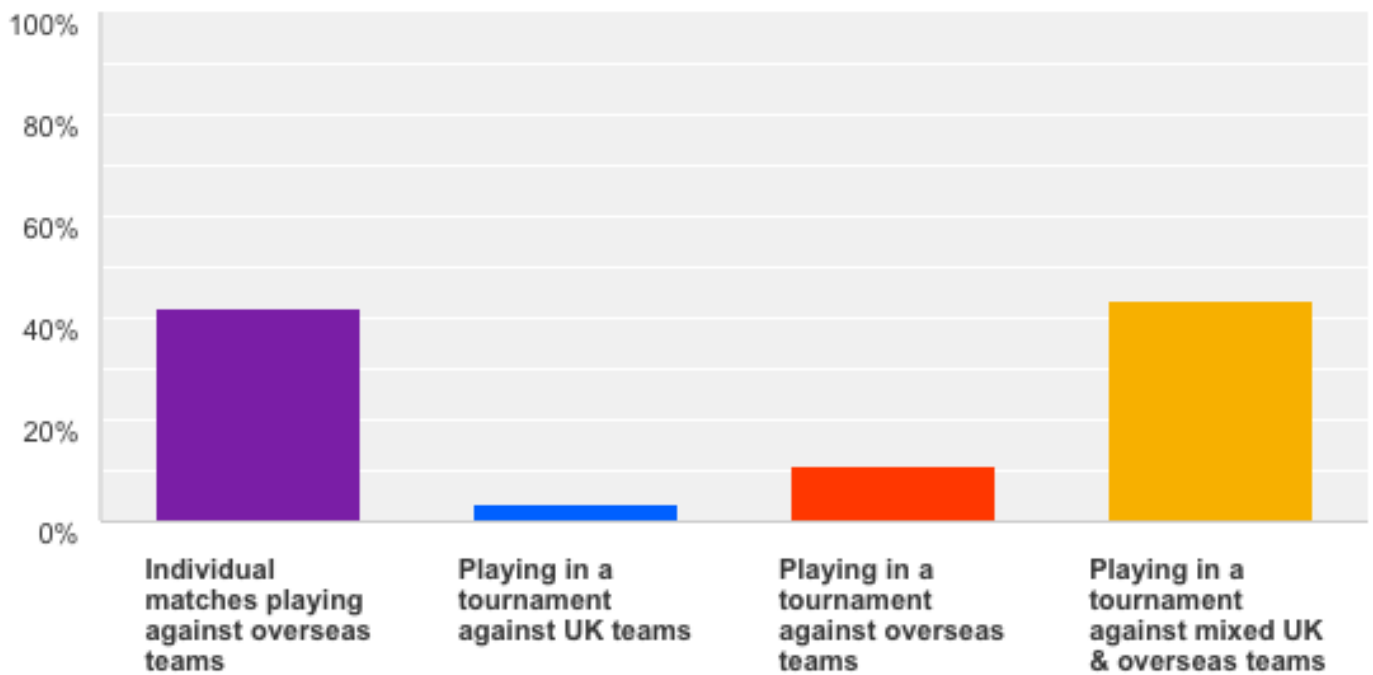

- Some tours are organised by ourselves and some through travel companies**

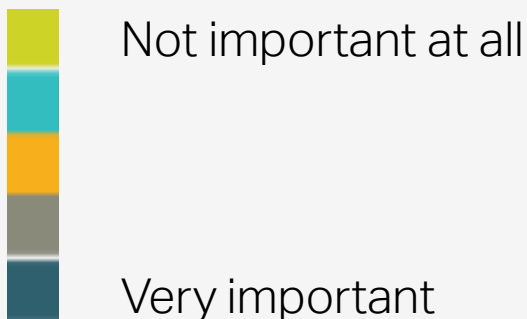
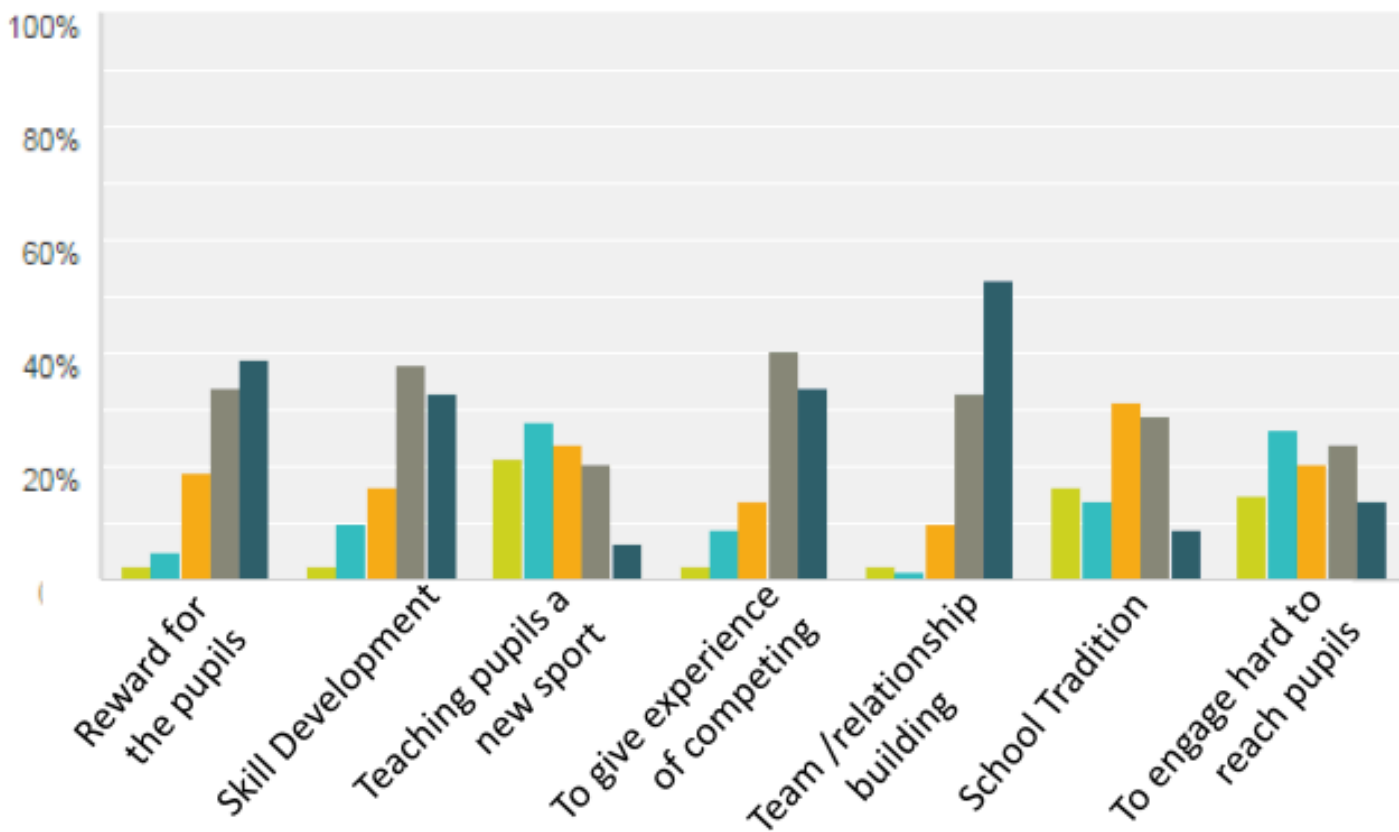
Factors affecting choice of travel company



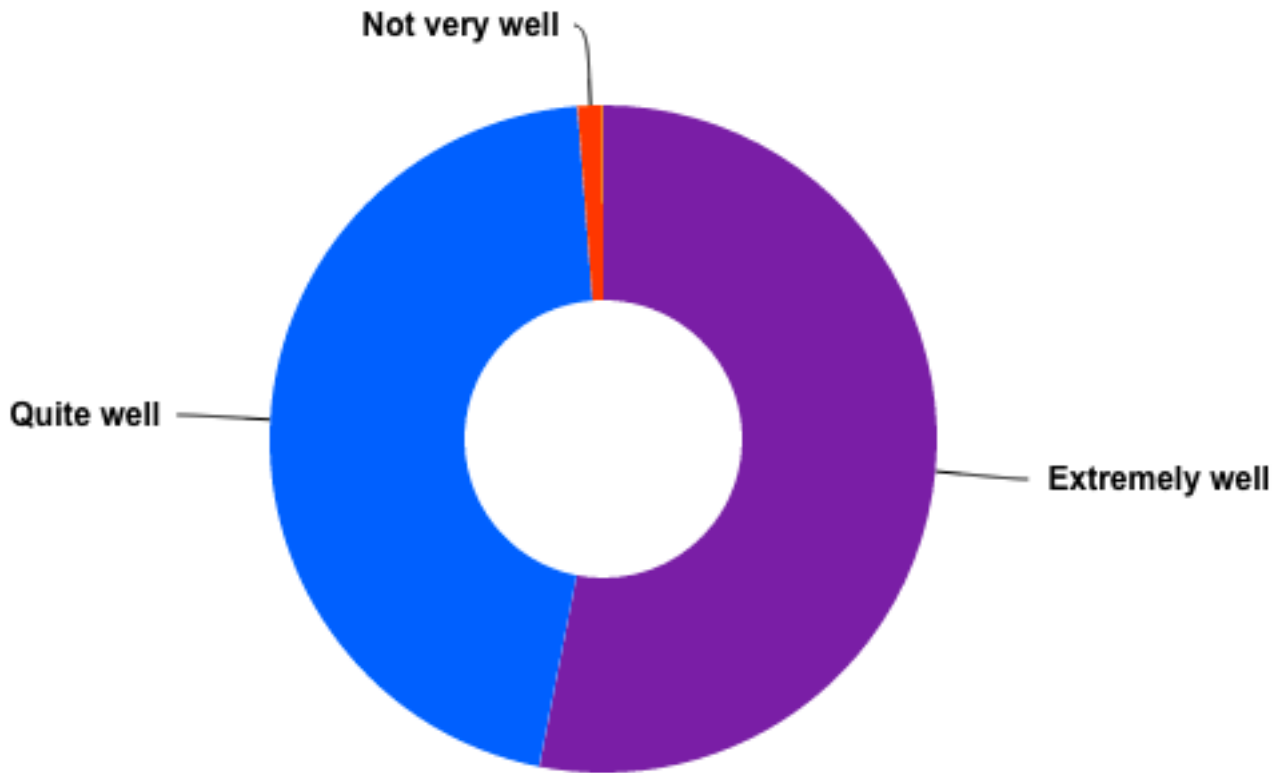
Preferred competitive format of sporting activity



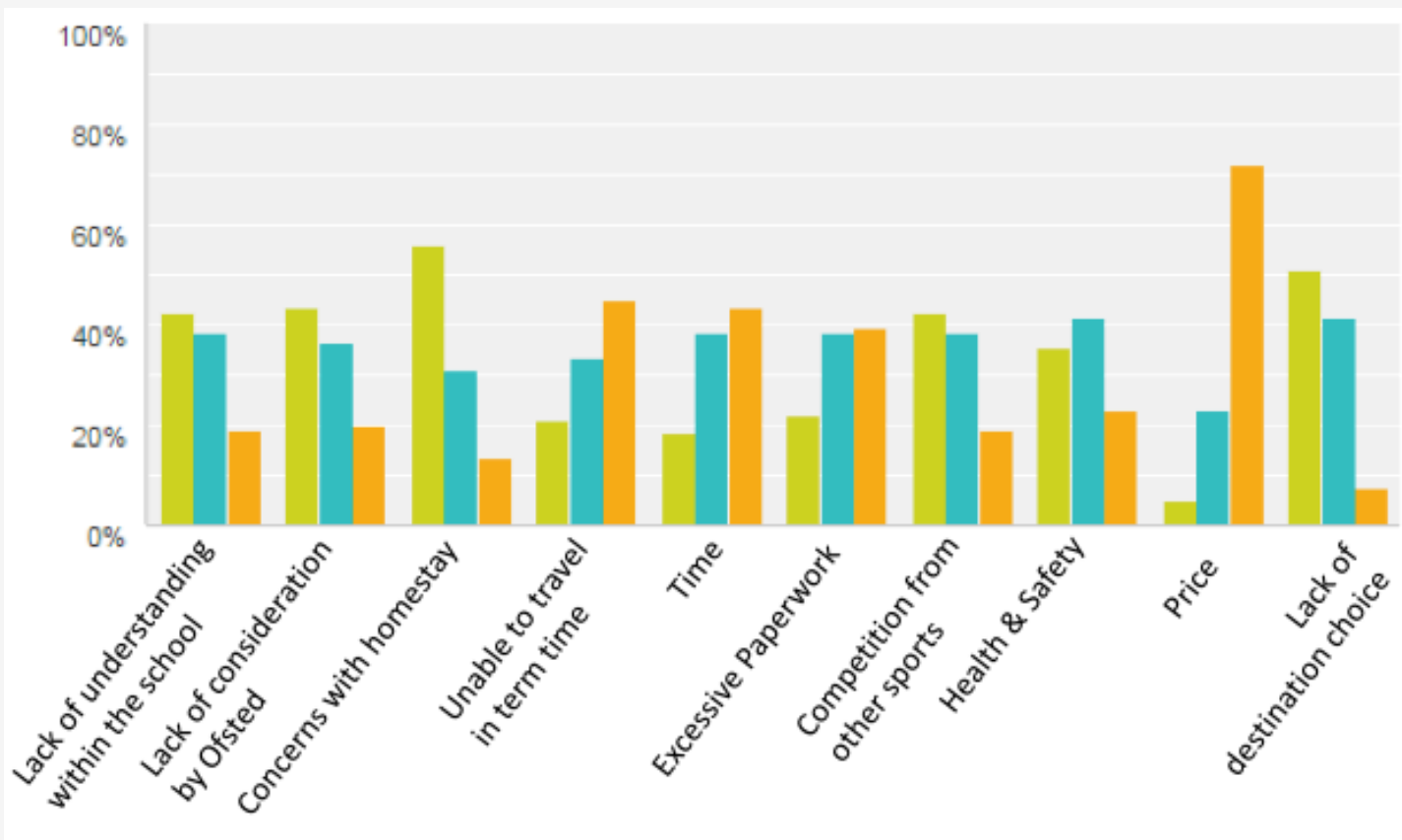
Factors when organising sport trips
